Requiring voter identification and proof of citizenship, paper ballots and public audits, publicly funded election administration, enforcement of election law, and verified voter-roll maintenance

PREAMBLE

WHEREAS, free, fair, transparent, and lawfully administered elections are indispensable to representative government and public confidence in its institutions; and

WHEREAS, [NAME OF BODY] finds that eligibility safeguards should verify both the identity and United States citizenship of persons registering and voting in New York State; and

WHEREAS, [NAME OF BODY] finds that hand-marked paper ballots, meaningful post-election audits, bipartisan observation, and strict chain-of-custody procedures provide essential means of verifying election results; and

WHEREAS, [NAME OF BODY] holds that election administration is a public responsibility that should be financed by public appropriation rather than private donors or organizations; and

WHEREAS, [NAME OF BODY] supports transparent investigation of documented irregularities, enforcement against verified violations, and accurate voter rolls maintained through reliable government records; and

WHEREAS, the people retain the right to petition public officials and election authorities for measures that protect lawful voting and the accurate counting of every eligible ballot;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that [NAME OF BODY], after due consideration, adopts the following provisions as its formal position and call to action:

OPERATIVE PROVISIONS

SECTION 1. [NAME OF BODY] demands enactment of mandatory photo voter identification and documentary proof of United States citizenship for all voter registration and voting in New York State;

SECTION 2. [NAME OF BODY] demands the exclusive use of hand-marked paper ballots in all elections, mandatory risk-limiting audits conducted publicly and with bipartisan observation, and strict chain-of-custody protocols for all ballots and election materials;

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OPERATIVE PROVISIONS — CONTINUED

SECTION 3. [NAME OF BODY] demands a complete prohibition on private, nonprofit, or billionaire funding of election offices, equipment, personnel, or operations, including but not limited to grants modeled on those of the Center for Tech and Civic Life (CTCL), and demands that election administration be funded exclusively through public appropriation;

SECTION 4. [NAME OF BODY] demands full forensic audits wherever documented irregularities exist, transparent public reporting of the findings, and aggressive prosecution of every verified instance of voter fraud, unlawful non-citizen voting, or other election-law violation;

SECTION 5. [NAME OF BODY] demands that New York withdraw from the Electronic Registration Information Center (ERIC) and implement real-time voter-roll maintenance using verified federal databases, including Social Security Administration death records, Department of Homeland Security immigration records, and United States Postal Service change-of-address data, subject to applicable privacy, security, accuracy, notice, and record-correction requirements.

FURTHER RESOLVED

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the officers and authorized representatives of [NAME OF BODY] shall advocate for the foregoing measures before the appropriate legislative bodies, election authorities, and executive officials and shall incorporate these positions into the body's election-integrity communications and legislative priorities;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that copies of this Resolution shall be transmitted to the Governor and Attorney General of New York, the leaders and members of the New York State Legislature, the New York State Board of Elections, appropriate county and local boards of elections, New York's congressional delegation, and any other officials with authority over the matters addressed herein;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall be made publicly available and may be circulated as a citizen petition, with [NAME OF BODY] authorized to collect and present signatures in support of its stated demands in accordance with applicable law;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption by [NAME OF BODY] and shall remain the stated position of [NAME OF BODY] unless amended or rescinded by subsequent action;

- ★ Conduct forensic audits where documented irregularities exist, report findings publicly, and prosecute verified violations.
