Calling for physical border security, immigration enforcement and removal operations, employment verification, consequences for sanctuary jurisdictions, and local cooperation with federal authorities

PREAMBLE

WHEREAS, the federal government bears responsibility for securing the Nation's borders and enforcing the immigration laws enacted by Congress; and

WHEREAS, [NAME OF BODY] finds that unlawful border crossings and policies that release inadmissible migrants into the United States undermine public safety, the rule of law, and confidence in lawful immigration; and

WHEREAS, it is the position of [NAME OF BODY] that the conditions at the southern border constitute an incursion requiring completion of effective physical barriers and consideration of the federal government's obligations under Article IV, Section 4 of the United States Constitution; and

WHEREAS, [NAME OF BODY] holds that immigration enforcement should prioritize criminal illegal aliens and recent unlawful arrivals, deter unauthorized employment, and end policies that obstruct cooperation with federal authorities; and

WHEREAS, consistent cooperation among federal, state, and local law-enforcement agencies is necessary for the effective execution of federal immigration law; and

WHEREAS, the people retain the right to petition their representatives for border security and the faithful enforcement of duly enacted immigration laws;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that [NAME OF BODY], after due consideration, adopts the following provisions as its formal position and call to action:

OPERATIVE PROVISIONS

SECTION 1. [NAME OF BODY] demands completion of the southern border wall and all necessary physical barriers and calls upon the United States Congress and the President to formally recognize the border incursion as an invasion under Article IV, Section 4 of the United States Constitution and to employ all lawful military assistance available to repel it;

SECTION 2. [NAME OF BODY] demands immediate large-scale deportation operations, consistent with due process and applicable law, beginning with criminal illegal aliens and recent unlawful arrivals; the permanent termination of catch-and-release policies; and restoration of the Remain in Mexico policy;

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OPERATIVE PROVISIONS — CONTINUED

SECTION 3. [NAME OF BODY] demands mandatory nationwide E-Verify for every employer, severe civil and criminal penalties for knowing noncompliance as authorized by law, and a surge in interior enforcement, including workplace actions against employers that knowingly hire illegal labor;

SECTION 4. [NAME OF BODY] demands, to the fullest extent permitted by law, that federal funding be withheld from any city, county, or state that refuses to cooperate with United States Immigration and Customs Enforcement or maintains sanctuary policies that obstruct federal immigration law;

SECTION 5. [NAME OF BODY] calls upon the appropriate county sheriff and all local law-enforcement agencies serving the jurisdiction represented by [NAME OF BODY] to cooperate fully with federal immigration authorities and to adopt formal resolutions affirming that cooperation.

FURTHER RESOLVED

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the officers and authorized representatives of [NAME OF BODY] shall advocate for the foregoing measures, request formal responses from officials with relevant authority, and encourage lawful coordination among federal, state, and local agencies;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that copies of this Resolution shall be transmitted to the President of the United States, the Secretary of Homeland Security, the Director of United States Immigration and Customs Enforcement, the Commissioner of United States Customs and Border Protection, the majority and minority leaders of both houses of Congress, New York's congressional delegation, the Governor and Attorney General of New York, and appropriate county sheriffs and local law-enforcement leaders;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall be made publicly available and may be circulated as a citizen petition, with [NAME OF BODY] authorized to collect and transmit signatures supporting the demands stated herein in accordance with applicable law;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption by [NAME OF BODY] and shall remain the stated position of [NAME OF BODY] unless amended or rescinded by subsequent action;

- ★ Withhold federal funding from jurisdictions that obstruct ICE or maintain sanctuary policies.
