PREAMBLE

WHEREAS, [NAME OF BODY] recognizes parents as the primary guardians of their children’s upbringing and education and holds that schools must respect parental authority, informed consent, and meaningful opt-out rights; and

WHEREAS, [NAME OF BODY] finds that public confidence in education depends upon full transparency concerning curricula, lesson plans, reading lists, instructional materials, programs, and student activities; and

WHEREAS, [NAME OF BODY] takes the position that instruction and school practices concerning race, sex, and gender must not displace parental rights or occur without the express parental consent specified in this Resolution; and

WHEREAS, [NAME OF BODY] believes families should have access to a broad range of educational options and should be empowered to direct the education of their children; and

WHEREAS, [NAME OF BODY] supports returning education authority from the federal government to the states, localities, and families; and

WHEREAS, the people retain the right to petition public officials and education authorities for reforms that protect parental authority, transparency, educational opportunity, and the welfare of children;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that [NAME OF BODY], after due consideration, adopts the following provisions as its formal position and call to action:

OPERATIVE PROVISIONS

SECTION 1. [NAME OF BODY] demands passage of a strong Parental Bill of Rights guaranteeing parents full transparency, informed consent, and opt-out rights concerning all curricula, materials, programs, and activities involving their children, with all lesson plans, reading lists, and instructional materials posted online for public review;

SECTION 2. [NAME OF BODY] demands, through constitutionally lawful legislation and policy, a complete ban in all New York public schools on: (a) Critical Race Theory and the 1619 Project; (b) gender-ideology instruction, the social gender transitioning of students, and the use of preferred pronouns without explicit written parental consent; and (c) all materials, training programs, and influence from the Southern Poverty Law Center in K–12 education and teacher professional development;

OPERATIVE PROVISIONS — CONTINUED

SECTION 3. [NAME OF BODY] demands expansion of school choice in New York through Education Savings Accounts, vouchers, tax-credit scholarships, and charter-school authorization, thereby empowering parents, rather than bureaucrats, to direct their children's education;

SECTION 4. [NAME OF BODY] demands abolition of the United States Department of Education and the return of all education authority to the states, localities, and families.

FURTHER RESOLVED

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the officers and authorized representatives of [NAME OF BODY] shall advocate for the foregoing policies before the appropriate local, state, and federal authorities and shall report to the body on material legislative or administrative action concerning them;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that certified copies of this Resolution shall be transmitted to the Governor of New York, the New York State Commissioner of Education, members of the New York State Legislature, the President of the United States, the United States Secretary of Education, and members of Congress, as applicable;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall be made publicly available as a citizen petition, and that [NAME OF BODY] may collect supporting signatures at its events, community gatherings, houses of worship, and public forums;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption by [NAME OF BODY] and shall constitute the official position of the body unless amended or rescinded by subsequent action;
